

Preamble

Lou Razzi was a member of Latrobe that showed a passion and energy to help the club become a better place. His passions in life were simple; family, the welfare of his boys at his work and his golf club. The tragedy of his sudden death in 2012 left a legacy to create a scholarship to continue on a vision he had to help Latrobe Golf Club foster and encourage junior golf. In keeping with his life's philosophes, the Scholarship was to help juniors experience the benefits socially of a club environment and to be the best that they can be.

Purpose

The Lou Razzi Junior Scholarship is designed to assist young golfers become members at Latrobe Golf Club and assist them in their development to adulthood. It will be dependent on their enthusiasm to be involved in the club, their results at either school or tertiary education and their behaviours both at Latrobe and in the general community. The Lou Razzi Junior Scholarship holders will be motivated to be outstanding individuals in all aspects of their lives.

Custodians

The selection of the Lou Razzi Scholarships awardees will be the current Board of the Latrobe Golf Club after consultation and approval from the General Manager of Melbourne Pipelines. The decision will be final.

Scholarship Fund Raising

The funds used for the Lou Razzi Junior Scholarship will be sourced mainly from the annual Melbourne Pipelines Golf Day at Latrobe Golf Club as well as from donations. The funds will be managed by the Latrobe Golf Club in a Scholarship Fund.

Criteria for selection

Open for male or female golfers eligible for membership in the Junior and Young Adult 18 – 24 year categories. The nominee must be enrolled in an education facility either still in the state school system or formal recognized tertiary education in Victoria. The nominee must become a member of the Latrobe Golf Club

Parameters to maintain the scholarship

- The Scholarship holder shall be active in the clubs environment. Unless injured, they must play in competitions at Latrobe a minimum of twice per month and be eligible for selection in the clubs representative sides should they be considered.
- The Scholarship holder must maintain at least a pass in their current schooling.
- The Scholarship holder must not be charged and found guilty of a criminal offence.
- The Scholarship holder must not be suspended or expelled from membership at Latrobe Golf Club.

The Lou Razzi Scholarship shall pay for the Scholarship Awardee:

10% of the Joining Fee applicable to that membership taken by the Scholarship holder. (This is the annual amount payable of the Joining fee.)

50% of the Membership Fee of the category the Scholarship Holder is eligible for that current membership year.
